Students should have or buy the following:

The American Ephemeris for the 21st Century (2000-2050), Michelsen, for noon **or** midnight.
Cost: £15.99 in 2007.

A set of Tables of Houses covering all latitudes. astrologycollege.com recommends students buy one of the following:

The Michelsen Book of Tables: contains Tables of Houses from 0° - 60° North for both Koch and Placidus house cusps and can be used for Equal House cusps as well. Cost: £12.99 in 2007. **or**

The AFA Tables of Houses for Placidus (can also be used for Equal house cusps). This is about the same price as the Michelsen Book of Tables and is available in the United States. Both the Michelsen and AFA Tables of Houses can be used for latitudes in both the northern and the southern hemispheres.

If you have **not** done Module 3b (Chart Calculation) of the Foundation Course with astrologycollege.com, you will also need:

The American Ephemeris for the 20th Century, Michelsen, for noon or midnight. Cost: Noon ephemeris £23. Midnight Ephemeris £19.99. Costs in 2007.

If you have ephemerides for the 20th and first half of the 21st century which are not **The American Ephemerides** referred to above, this may not be a problem, but please consult the college by post, telephone or email (admin@astrologycollege.com).

Module 7

You will need to buy a book for the lesson on Midpoints which is **Midpoints, Identify & Integrate Midpoints into Horoscope Synthesis**, by Don McBroom, Special Topics in Astrology series, Llewellyn Publications, 2007, cost £14.99.

You will also need to buy **Collins Pocket Guide, Stars and Planets**, by Ian Ridpath and Wil Tirion. HarperCollins Publishers, cost about £15.00. It is advisable to wait till you have received the Course Manual (Lessons and Exercises) which gives more information on what precisely you need, in case you cannot buy this particular publication. There are alternatives.
